Campus Security

The *Campus Sex Crimes Prevention Act (CSCPA)* is a federal law enacted on October 28, 2000. Among other things, this law facilitates the tracking of convicted, registered sex offenders that are: 1) students of, 2) employees of, or 3) volunteers at an institute of higher education. The CSCPA amends the *Jacob Wetterling Crimes Against Children and Sexually Violent Offender Registration Act (WETTERLING)* to require sex offenders that are already required to register in a State to provide notice, as required under State Law, of each institution of higher education in that State at which the person is employed or carries on a vocation or is a student effective as of October 28, 2002. The CSCPA also amends the *Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (CLERY)* to require institutions of higher education to issue a statement, in addition to other disclosure required under offenders is provided by their State. Finally, the CSCPA amends the *Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)* to state that nothing in FERPA can prohibit an institute of higher education from disclosing information concerning registered sex offenders.
