RETENTION RATES

Percentage of Students Who Began Their Studies in Fall 2017 and Returned in Fall 2018

Retention Rate for First Time Students: 76%

GRADUATION & TRANSFER OUT RATES

Percentage of students who began their studies as full-time, first-time degree- or certificate-seeking students that complete a degree or other award such as a certificate within 150% of "normal time" for completing the program in which they are enrolled.
