

HEERF II and III REPORTING ON EMERGENCY FINANCIAL AID GRANTS TO STUDENTS

Through the *Coronavirus Response & Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA)*, Milwaukee Career College has been awarded additional funds by the U.S. Department of Education to assist students impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic to continue their education. \$203,068.00 has been awarded for student recovery.

Through the *American Rescue Plan Act (ARP)*, Milwaukee Career College has been awarded additional funds by the U.S. Department of Education to make emergency financial aid awards to assist students impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic to continue their education. \$121,337.00 has been awarded for student recovery. The college will begin awarding and distributing these funds as soon as all HEERF II-CRRSAA funds have been dispersed.

The law requires institutions to report certain information related to the use of these funds. The following information is reported for the period, April 15, 2021 to September 30, 2021. As of October 1, 2021, the institution will update this report quarterly. Information will be updated and posted no later than January 10, April 10, and July 10, 2022.

- I. This statement shall serve to acknowledge that our institution signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that we have used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- II. The total amount of funds that the institution has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Student under the CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4): \$324,405.00
- III. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4) as of March 31, 2022: \$119,000.00
- IV. The estimated total number of students at our institution eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under the CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4): 174
- V. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4) to date: 119
- VI. The following is the method used by our institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much each student has received under the CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4).
 - A student who receives PELL grants, or demonstrates needs due to changes in financial situation because of COVID-19 for a non-PELL recipient;
 - A student must have been in an active status on or after April 15, 2021;

- A student must be currently active, on an approved Leave of Absences (LOA), or have graduated on or after April 15, 2021;
- A student must submit the Student Form in the next page.

VII. All eligible students who submitted the Student form will receive the HEERF Grant funds while available. HEERF Grant amounts were established based on the estimated number of eligible students and the total amount of funds granted to the institution. Disbursements will be disbursed in two equal payments. The first disbursement will occur within 14 days of receipt of the form, and the second disbursement will occur on or after January 31, 2022.
